The railway is recognized as one of the safest modes of transport. However, this introduces the risk of taking safety for granted.

To maintain a steadfast focus on safety, we have established this safety policy under the principle that safety is fundamental to any operation.

Our Core Belief:

Our customers must be able to take safety for granted - we must never do that!

We are fundamentally convinced that:

- Accidents can be prevented
- Safety is the foremost priority for all employees and partners
- You see it, you own it – if you ignore it, you accept it
- It should be straightforward to act safely

We are committed to achieving the highest safety level by:

- Ensuring the safety policy is implemented throughout the organization
- Maintaining, adhering to, and continuously developing a safety management system in line with best practices and relevant legislation
- Setting clear goals for safety activities and close monitoring hereof
- Developing and maintaining robust safety competencies
- Proactively working to prevent and eliminate safety risks
- Addressing unsafe behaviors and fostering open discussions about safety challenges
- Reporting incidents and near-misses with an emphasis on learning and preventing recurrence
- Promoting a safety culture that acknowledges unintentional errors can occur and can be reported without fear of consequences
- Taking responsibility for one's own safety and that of others
- Recognizing that human errors is a reality, however, intentional violations of safety protocols will not be tolerated
- Upholding that adherence to safe practices is a fundamental requirement for employment
